Directions to S&T Athletics Facility

From I-44 West (From St. Louis): Take the third Rolla exit #185. At the top of the ramp, turn left onto University Drive and proceed to the stoplight. At stoplight, turn right onto Hwy. 63/Bishop Ave. and stay in the right lane. At the next stoplight, turn right onto 10th St. Make your first left into the parking lot at Gale-Bullman Multipurpose Bldg.

From I-44 East (From Springfield): Take the second Rolla exit #185. At the top of the ramp, turn right onto University Drive and proceed to the stoplight. At stoplight, turn right onto Hwy. 63/Bishop Ave. and stay in the right lane. At the next stoplight, turn right onto 10th St. Make your first left into the parking lot at Gale-Bullman Multipurpose Bldg.

North Bound on Highway 63: Stay on Hwy. 63 going north into Rolla. Turn left onto 10th St. Make your first left into the parking lot at Gale-Bullman Multipurpose Bldg.

South Bound on Highway 63: Stay on Hwy. 63 going south into Rolla. Turn right onto 10th St. Make your first left into the parking lot at Gale-Bullman Multipurpose Bldg.

From Hwy. 72: Take Hwy. 72 to the intersection of Hwy. 72 and 63. Turn right. Stay on Hwy. 63 going north through Rolla. Turn left onto 10th St. Make your first left into the parking lot at Gale-Bullman Multipurpose Bldg.

Camp Philosophy

The camp is designed to teach fundamental basketball skills to young players entering grades 3 through 10 in Fall 2009. Campers will be divided into groups based on age and ability. An emphasis will be placed on the development of shooting, ball handling, rebounding, passing, and defensive skills. Time will also be spent on footwork, pivots, balance, and proper positioning. We will have 8 ft. goals for younger campers.

Registration

Registration form and camp fee should be submitted prior to June 15th. Additional campers will be allowed to register on the first day of camp by 8:30 am as space permits (provided the staff to camper ratio will not be affected in a way that diminishes the quality of the camp).

Contests

Campers will have the opportunity to participate in free throw, hot shot, speed dribbling, three-on-three, and one-on-one contests. Five-on-five games will also be a part of daily activities. Prizes will be awarded for all contest winners.

T-shirt

All participants will receive a camp t-shirt. Be sure to mark the appropriate size on the registration form.

Equipment

Players must provide their own shoes. Basketballs will be provided for use during camp.

Location

The camps will be held on the Missouri S&T campus in the Student Recreation Gym on the lower level of the Gale Bullman Multipurpose Building. The Gale Bullman Building is located at the corner of 10th St and Hwy 63 in Rolla, MO.
